Ely United Methodist Church Members/Friends,

Greetings from Pastor Craig! The Minnesota Fishing Opener has arrived, so now another glorious Northern-Minnesota-Summer has begun!

This milestone is always a glad occasion, even more so this year with the CDC's announcement yesterday that fully vaccinated individuals may move about outdoors and indoors without masks.

How different things feel, for me anyhow, from last year when at this time there was a near total shutdown.

Item #1: Here's an update for how things are on the ground with our church as of today.

- People worshipping in-person continue to wear masks whenever inside our building. Worship leaders, all fully vaccinated, do not wear masks when speaking, but keep distance from the congregation and each other.
- There were 50 people in worship last Sunday. We continue to seat people every other row and in family groupings, however we suggest you let ushers know if there are non-family members in attendance who you are comfortable sitting with. This allows us to increase the number of people attending worship services upstairs.
- Prior to Governor Walz' announcement small groups of vaccinated individuals have been meeting unmasked with the consensus of all group members.
- Our Administrative Council will meet next Wednesday (May 19) to review our existing policies, making adjustments as necessary.

As always, we will provide updates in Parish News as they happen.

Meanwhile, please continue to call Jeanne Tomlinson at 218-235-8470 if you wish to attend worship in-person. When you call, please let us know if there are non-family members that you would be willing to sit

with because you spend time with them outside church. This helps us increase the number of people who can sit in the sanctuary and keep social distance.

Item #2: Yesterday we successfully created a new Ely United Methodist Church Facebook Account. The name is "Eumc MN." Notice the upper case/lower case letters and the space between the "c" and the "MN."

We successfully paired our camera with this new site and did two test recordings. This is our present plan for making the transition from our old page to our new page.

1. We will probably live-stream via the laptop one more week from our existing (old) Facebook page – "Ely United Methodist Church." The reason is people who access our worship services but do not have a personal Facebook account will not be able to link to our broadcast until enough people friend, follow, or like our new page.

2. So, would you please search for our new page (Eumc MN) and send us a friend request?

- 3. We will post updates as they happen on our old/existing page, detailing where we are in this transition. We will also post updates here in *Parish News*.
- 4. We will keep our existing page for the time being so people can access past worship service.

Please call me at the church (218-365-3355) during office hours or reply to this email with any questions and I'll give you a call to help you sort this all out. My office hours are 9:00 – Noon on Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.

Thank you for your patience as we navigate this unpleasant interruption in live-streaming our worship services with our high-quality camera. We're grateful for your interest in participating in our services online. We will continue to live-stream them even when the pandemic is over.
