A Note from Pastor Craig

Thanksgiving is November 24, a week from yesterday. This Sunday in worship we will sing Thanksgiving hymns and hear Thanksgiving Scripture lessons read.

Since we don't have a Thanksgiving service, I want to comment briefly on Thanksgiving 2022, because only three days later we'll be into Advent where our hearts and minds turn toward the birth of Jesus Christ.

As I write these words, I am reflecting back to Thanksgiving 2020; the Thanksgiving smack dab in the heart of the first year of the pandemic and during a huge spike of infections and deaths. And we were coming off a contested election. Can you put yourself back in that moment?

There were warnings from medical experts and persons in the healthcare field about limiting our gatherings. I don't recall now if the airlines were transporting passengers or not, but there was a lot of freefloating anxiety in families and communities. As I remember the virus had run through several Ely area deer camps resulting in several fatalities.

I had mostly recovered from my early October Covid-19 infection. But I wasn't traveling anywhere and my mood was subdued. I remember posting a Thanksgiving video meditation on our church Facebook account from my bedroom in the parsonage. Someone later commented to me how sad and subdued I looked and sounded. This was despite my theme being the prophet Habakkuk's hopeful message during the Jewish national crisis 400 years before the birth of Christ. "Though the fig tree does not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation." (From Habakkuk 3:17-18)

Well, here we are two years later; while the pandemic isn't conclusively over, families who choose can safely sit around the Thanksgiving table with loved ones. And whether the candidates for office we voted for won or lost, reporting suggests this was a fair election - the election process "worked." In this light I wish you a blessed Thanksgiving!
