Their importance directly informs the way we value ourselves, view friends and strangers alike, and for how we conduct ourselves around the rest of God's sons and daughters. This week we'll look at what her words mean for the way we value ourselves.

We've heard the following words from the biblical book of Genesis, chapter 1, verse 27 so often they can sound commonplace: *"S o God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them."*

But what does it mean to be created in "the image of God?" Robinson suggests the following: The fact we have a soul "uniquely invests each individual person with an absolute dignity and significance. This understanding places great value in the individual and, at the same time, finds great significance in the moment-to-moment conduct of mortal life." (What are We Doing Here, p. 212)

In other words, not only do each of us have a spark of the divine within, but also that particular reflection of God is unique. Your soul is different from anyone else who ever has been or ever will be. (This includes my identical twin brother and me!)

Jesus Christ and the Scriptures are the two main ways God chooses to be made known to us, in that order. Yet, God also chooses to be revealed to the world through us humans! Through you, uniquely, through me, and through each one of God's sons and daughters.

Would you feel differently about yourself, if you found ten minutes or so every day to consider this in silence? There is awe to this, but also humility. Awe to recognize our dignity; humility to recognize the same in others. God's peace be with you. Pastor Craig
