A Note from Pastor Craig

All four Advent Candles will be lit when we gather for Christmas Eve worship at 5:30 on December 24th. Once again we'll welcome the birth of the Christ Child, as have Jesus' followers around the world for centuries. "Joy to the World the Lord is Come!"

The term "Incarnation" is given to this miraculous event, where God's own self has come to dwell with us as a human being. The human being Jesus is also God's anointed, the Christ, who has come reveal God in all God's fullness and to take upon himself all the sin, evil, and brokenness of the world. The bringing back of broken individuals and humanity to God happens through him.

The entire structure of the Old Testament has anticipated this sort of revelation from God, has pictured God coming to redeem Israel from all its enemies. We understand who Jesus was and who Jesus is in light of Old Testament prophecies. Our Jewish brothers and sisters, from whom we have received these Scriptures, have a different understanding, which we honor. For us, however, we see Jesus Christ as God's defining revelation "in the fullness of time."

In other words, we rejoice with Mary, Joseph, the shepherds, wise men, and others who found their way to the manger to worship and have followed Jesus ever since. For followers of Jesus, he is Emmanuel, God with Us. He is the Light of the World, the light which shines in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it. The images for Jesus Christ are endless - The Good Shepherd, the Bread of Life, the True Vine, the Lamb of God, the Lion of Judah, and so on.

The most profound art across the centuries has inspired us humans as composers, painters, sculptors, and authors have used their immense gifts in seeking to evoke the wonder of these glad tidings within us - Handel's Messiah, Michelangelo's paintings on the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel, Christina Rossetti, who wrote "In the Bleak Winter" and "Love Came Down at Christmas."

All this, whether Scripture, Christmas Carols, or art, brings this miracle to you and me and it is at this point where you and I make it our own by opening our heart and life to the Good News of the Christ Child. Or as Phillips Brooks wrote in the moving hymn "O Little Town of Bethlehem."

How silently, how silently, the wondrous gift is given;
So God imparts to human hearts the blessings of his heaven.
No ear may hear his coming, but in this world of sin,

Where meek souls will receive him, still the dear Christ enters in.

My very best wishes are with you and yours for a Joyous Christmas.

Worship Services on December 24th and December 31st

Christmas Eve: Our Christmas Eve Service will be at 5:30 on December 24th. It will be the traditional service of Christmas Carols and Scripture Readings. The choir will sing an introit and an anthem, Suzanne Mades will play a flute solo, and I will preach a brief sermon.

The candle lighting will be near the end of the service. The light of the Christ Child will be passed through the sanctuary from person to person, as we light our individual candles. We'll sing "Silent Night" in the darkened sanctuary while seated. When we're finished singing we'll have a brief time of silence to fully absorb the moment, then we'll turn the lights back on and stand to sing "Joy to the World."

We will not pass an offering plate, but there will be an offering plate in the church narrhex at the rear of the church where people may leave an offering.

Individuals/Families who purchased poinsettias in memory of a loved one may take them home following the Christmas Eve Service.

Christmas Eve Day: We'll hold our usual Sunday morning 10:00 a.m. worship service. The Sunday December 24th service will feature Christmas Carols. The first reading will be the account of the angel Gabriel coming to visit Mary announcing that she will bear a son, who will be called "The Son of the Most High." Following the angel's departure, Mary immediately travels to see Elizabeth, who has also conceived following an angel's visit to her husband. The second reading will be Mary's song of praise when the two women meet and share their mutual joy. There will be Sunday School this morning.

New Year's Eve Day (December 31): We'll once again gather New Year's Eve Day for worship at 10:00. The morning service will be a "Watch Night" service of sorts, when we'll look forward to 2024 and consider our preparation to receive what God, the one who "makes all things new," will bring to us. Once again we will have Sunday School.

Rule of Christ Training - Save the Date

John Nowell from the Minnesota Annual Conference will be at our church on Sunday, January 28, 2024 for a Rule of Christ training. The Rule of Christ teaches congregations good communication.
