The **Worship Committee** will be meeting with Mike Trumbull to discuss the upcoming Prayer Workshops.

- 1. **Vital Congregations Revitalization Plan.** We are waiting for more direction from the MN Conference office to complete.
- 2. B.S.A Venturing Crew Sponsorship. We are waiting for the B.S.A National office to notify us of the approval of the charter of this new scout unit.
- 3. The **Church Visioning Committee** is approaching the completion of the Church's Visioning Plan. Many parts of the plan have been started. The committee will continue to assess the execution and impact of the plan's initiatives.
- 4. **Dale Arendt Meeting** Dana and members of our congregation met with Dale Arendt on Sunday January 30 in Virginia, to discuss ideas on revitalizing our church. Some good information was received by the visioning committee members.
