2014 Church Budget Set:

The Church Finance Committee met on Thursday November 7, 2013 to determine the Church's Budget for 2014. The end result is an estimate that the cost of operating the Church will be about \$100,000, or about \$130 more than the estimated cost of operation in 2013.

The Budget was developed by the committee by using known operating costs for the coming year – Conference Apportionments and Ministerial Support – and also making estimates of the other costs of operation of the Church.

The Finance Committee feels these Budget Expenses are realistic, conservative and achievable by the Church.

The Finance Committee is sharing this cost of operation estimate with each of the members of Ely UMC because – we; The Members; are the primary source of the money needed to pay these operating expenses.

The Finance Committee is telling each of us that if each of us increased our giving by 2 Cents for each Dollar we have given this year, the Church's revenue increase will be adequate to cover expenses.

We - as Members of the Ely UMC – must remember that the costs of operation of the Church need to be met, whether we are able to attend the Church's Worship Services or not.

GRASS IS GREEN --- SNOW IS WHITE !!!

We are now looking for volunteers for sidewalk snow shoveling for the winter months. We need to keep the Church sidewalks and entryways clear of snow and Ice during the winter months. Mark & Margie Olson have signed up for November, so December thru April need to be filled. Volunteers can sign up for a month at a time by themselves or get together with other people and do a month that way.

The walkways and sidewalks to the church entrances – the front door, the handicapped ramp and the rear door to the Fellowship Hall (basement) – must be kept safe for walking and be welcoming to those coming to the Church during the winter months.

The maintenance of the sidewalks entails the removal of snow and ice in a timely manner after a snowfall, to ensure the sidewalks are as safe as possible. These tools are stored in the Church garage during the summer months and are placed next to the front doors and the back door to the Fellowship hall during the winter months.
