"That same day Jesus went out

As for what was sown on rocky ground, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; yet such a person has no root, but endures only for a while and when trouble or persecution arises on account of the word, that person immediately falls away. As for what was sown among thorns, this is the one who hears the word, but the cares of the world and the lure of wealth choke the word and it yields nothing. But as for what was sown on good soil, this is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields, in one case a hundred fold, in another sixty, and in another thirty."
