Gail has composed a written appeal for volunteers that can be inserted into the Sunday worship bulletin, so we now have 3 separate write-ups. A sign-up sheet with an explanation stressing that the individual commitment need not be burdensome has also been completed. We also will need to put in the September newsletter a call for students. With respect to background checks, Rich is waiting for a response from “Safe Gatherings,” an entity that the Minnesota Conference contracts with for background checks and training. To date, we know the cost for the background checks and the training, and that Safe Gatherings recommends renewing them every 3 years. We think the school system regards a background check as indefinite. The Visioning Committee recommends once every 5 years. As soon as Rich finds out how people can apply for the background checks with the church paying for them, all volunteers should all begin the process. We plan to start the instruction on the first Wednesday in October, with sessions running from about 3:30 until 5:00.

Bring a Kid to Church Month – September is Bring a Kid to Church Month. To advertize it, Rich will write an article to put in the *Fish*. The same article can be used in bulletins. Jan volunteered her kids to make posters to put up in the church. She will also make announcements during church service. We will purchase 30 books entitled *Jesus is Calling You* for those children who got Bibles last year, and 10 (or more if we get a price break) children’s Bibles for those who did not get them.

Bible Study – We discussed the possibility of have a Bible study in January, February, or March. Two possible studies include one on Forgiveness and one called Soul Keeping.
